Heart Attack

- Intensive care room: \$8,000 to \$12,000/day
- Angioplasty: \$6,000 to \$7,000
- ECG: \$5280 to \$360
- Cardiac catheterization: \$40,278 to \$63,558
- Defibrillator implant: \$27,000 to \$35,000*
- Average annual insurance premium for family coverage: \$11,480
